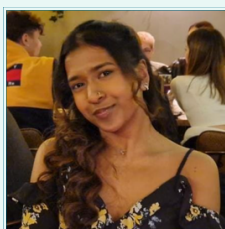

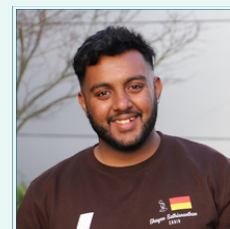

STUDENT SUPPORT & MENTORSHIP

Throughout 2023, we have delivered a range of workshops and networking events, empowering students to explore various job opportunities through direct interactions with industry professionals.

In collaboration with organisations such as *The Tamil Endowment Fund* and the *Association of British Tamil Lawyers*, we have delivered targeted workshops, allowing students to develop an understanding of a range of industries and roles.

Our commitment to supporting students extends beyond London's geographical boundaries. We have collaborated with various university Tamil Societies across the UK, ensuring that our events are accessible to all students irrespective of their geographical location.

These events are open to students from all universities, free of charge, to ensure that financial barriers do not hinder students from accessing valuable career support.

In August 2023, TPN launched its **Student Mentorship Programme**, designed to provide direct mentorship to students throughout the academic year of 2023/24. 62 students are currently enrolled in this programme, benefiting from invaluable insights provided by mentors in their desired industry.

Our mentors offer tailored support and skill development opportunities, allowing students to build professional connections in their desired industry. By leveraging the wealth of experiences shared by their mentor, students gain invaluable insights and cultivate meaningful relationships.



HSBC TAMIL STUDENTS INSIGHT DAYS

On 23rd June 2023, 30 Tamil students aged 15-18 were welcomed to HSBC's Global Headquarters in Canary Wharf. The day featured engaging career-related workshops and was concluded with a tour of the 45-storey skyscraper, providing students with a unique insight into the corporate world.

Throughout the day, students developed an understanding of the banking industry and honed practical skills, including interview techniques and CV writing.

Following the resounding success of HSBC's first Tamil Students Insight Day, we had the privilege of facilitating a second event, this time welcoming 40 University students aged 18-22 into the bank.

These insight days serve as a catalyst to empower and motivate Tamil students in reaching their aspirations, providing a truly eye-opening experience. This invaluable opportunity has enabled students to cultivate and enhance their skillset, knowledge, and understanding of the wide range of roles across the banking sector.

university, aiding in the organisation of workshops and circulating upcoming events with their university Tamil Society.

We will also host several Experienced Professionals Network events to foster the exchange of ideas and knowledge across generations, ensuring that early-career professionals are equipped with the knowledge and skills to advance on their career journey.

Ultimately, TPN serves to ensure that all students and professionals, irrespective of their background, have access to opportunities. We recognise the unique challenges that many individuals face having escaped Sri Lanka's Civil War, and are committed to preventing a lack of opportunities from hindering the progress of the Tamil community.
